

Kinship Care Navigators and Legal Information Clinics Fall 2024

The Missouri Kinship Navigator Program provides information, resources, and support groups to kinship caregivers. Parent Link at the University of Missouri administers the program. Access to legal assistance was one of the top needs reported by caregivers. Mid Missouri Legal Services (MMLS) has been working with a group convened by Parent Link to organize legal information clinics in Central Missouri and plans are in the works for a clinic in Poplar Bluff. - Discuss next steps in your case and determine a path forward to achieve the desired outcome
- Receive resources for family mediation

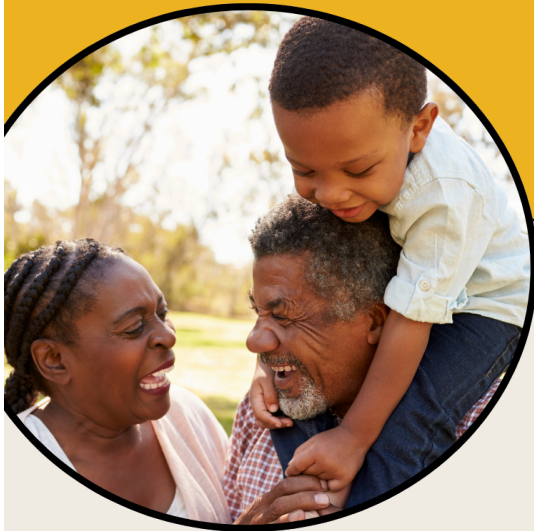

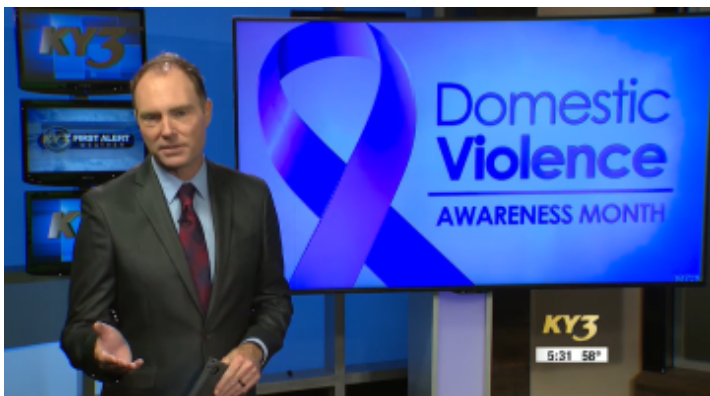
