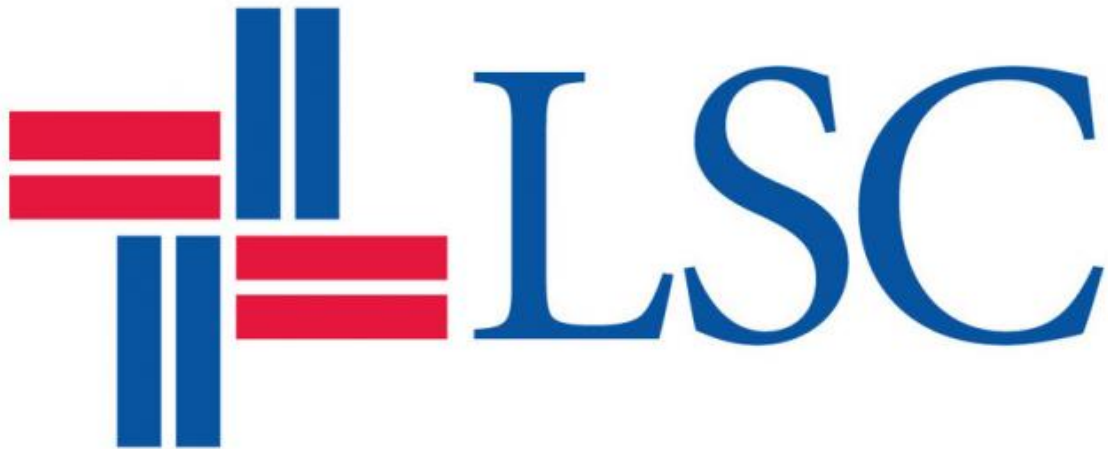


How Legal Aid Works
